Enjoy this fly-in safari adventure in Namibia. Visit the Namib Desert; a sea of dunes, a great sand sea. The only true African desert south of the equator. Then you'll fly high along the Skeleton Coast to Swakopmund and onwards to your lodge further up the Skeleton Coast before exploring Etosha National Park to end.



Flight: Windhoek – Sossusvlei 1 hour & 10 minutes

- You will be met on arrival by our representative to hand over your travel documents
- Meet your pilot and check in for your flight and briefing before taking to the Namibian skies
- Private charter flight from Windhoek to Sossusvlei over the Namib Naukluft Mountain Range
- Road transfer to the lodge on arrival
- Includes: All meals; 1x Nature drive,1x Excursion to Sossusvlei; Sesriem Canyon and Dead Vlei;
- 1x Guided nature walks; Hiking trail; 1x Quad bike excursion; San rock paintings; Stargazing at a state-of-the-art observatory; accompanied by a resident astronomer; Petrified dunes
- Highlights: Sossusvlei, Dead Vlei, Dune 45, Big Daddy, Elim Dune and the Sesriem Canyon

Overnight at Hoodia Desert Lodge.



Flight: Sossusvlei – Swakopmund Swakopmund – Möwe Bay 1 hour & 30 minutes (scenic) – refuel (30 minutes) 1 hour & 30 minutes

- Road transfer to airstrip for departure flight and to lodge on arrival
- Private charter scenic flight along the Skeleton Coast to Swakopmund to refuel
- Highlights: Sossusvlei, sand dunes, old diamond mines, shipwrecks & Sandwich Harbour
- Private charter flight from Swakopmund to Möwe Bay
- Includes: All meals, scheduled daily excursions, park fees & local branded drinks
- Activities: Game drives within the Skeleton Coast National Park, Sundowners and walks on the beach, fishing at the coastline (equipment provided), 4×4 excursions to the Clay Castles, the Hoanib River Delta and the Mowe Bay seal colony, visits to the Suiderkus and Karimona shipwrecks & drives along the Hoarusib River to track desert-adapted wildlife

Flight:Möwe Bay – Ondangwa1 hour & 25 minutes – refuel (30 minutes)Ondangwa - Etosha30 minutes

- Road transfer to airstrip for departure flight
- Private charter flight from Möwe Bay to Ondangwa to refuel and then on to Etosha National Park (east)
- Road transfer to the lodge on arrival
- Includes: All meals, Etosha AM drive & Onguma Sundowner drive (daily), park fees & local branded drinks
- Etosha is one of Africa's great game parks. With 114 species of mammal and 340 species of birds you are sure to see a great variety of wildlife on your safari

Flight: Etosha – Windhoek 1 hour & 40 minutes

- After your morning activity as included, you will road transfer to the airstrip for your departure flight.
- Private charter flight from Etosha to Windhoek International Airport. Keeping in mind that you need to be at the airport 2 hours prior to your international departure flight time.
